






Adding a New Point of Interest This screenshot shows the interface for adding new points of interest, where you typically input location names and addresses.




Updating Location Marker on Map This image illustrates how you can interact with the map to adjust the precise location of a point of interest by dragging its marker.




Removing a Point of Interest This screenshot likely displays a confirmation dialog or the interface for selecting and deleting an existing point of interest.
